“Girls Do The Math: Understanding And Reducing Gender Inequalities In Mathematics.”

The underrepresentation of women in mathematics is well known, yet gender inequalities persist and are even worsening. What makes mathematics less attractive to girls than other sciences? Is success in this field a matter of innate ability or acquired skills? Are there gender differences in interests and curiosity? Drawing on several sociological field studies, this talk explores how attitudes toward mathematics are constructed and suggests ways to reduce these inequalities.
